This upcoming holy season is a triduum, or three holy days of commemoration, focused on remembering and praying for the dead. Hallow means holy. Halloween, or All Hallow's Eve, is a night to prepare for All Saints Day on November 1st. We acknowledge death while also remembering Christ has already been victorious over it. November 1st is one of the six holy days of obligation in the United States for Catholics and we celebrate all of the saints, known and unknown, who now live with God in Heaven. On November 2nd, we celebrate All Souls Day and pray for all of the departed in Purgatory who are awaiting eternal life with God. This season is not one of darkness, but of great hope. A time to honor the holy lives of the men and women who came before us, and pray.
